SABIC UK PETROCHEMICALS TRANS-PENNINE ETHYLENE PIPELINE

Planning Application No 3/2021/0278, Ground mounted installation of solar array for energy generation **Location: Dudland Hollins, Gisburn**

Thank you for your recent planning application, Ref 3/2021/0278 dated 11 June 2021.

The proposed development is situated in the same parcel of land as the TPEP, and falls within the inner consultation zone of the above Major Accident Hazard Pipeline as defined by the HSE development control guidelines (PADHI - HSE's Land Use Planning Methodology document). I would advise that the fenced area is kept outside the pipeline 6m easement.

In terms of the safety and engineering integrity of the pipeline, the developer of the solar installation will need to submit their design drawings for approval. The areas of concern for SABIC are location of metallic structures / routing of electrical cables and the impact on land drainage schemes close to the pipeline.

I would also advise that SABIC is to be consulted for all work within 50 metres either side of the pipeline.
