**Planning Application 3/2021/0396: Discharge of Condition 5 (Written Scheme of Investigation) of Listed Building Consent application 3/2020/0740.**  
**Hark to Bounty Inn, Townend, Slaidburn BB7 3EP**

Thank you for your consultation on the above application. The application includes a Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI, Solstice Heritage LLP, March 2021) which sets out the outline of a level 1 building record and a watching brief on the above building. The planning condition however states that a rapid photographic survey and a watching brief are required. The latter section is appropriate but the former needs to note that a full photographic record will be made, rather than the outline record which is implied by the 'level 1' record that is proposed.

If this issue can be addressed, then the WSI can be approved, but we would (as usual) recommend that the condition itself is not discharged until the work has been completed and a satisfactory report submitted.
