The development at Greenbank Park and Haven holiday park has already increased traffic along Higher road to an Unacceptable level. This proposed new housing development could Potentially add a further 200 cars to the situation.

Longridge is being overdeveloped, the infrastructure cannot cope. Has anyone from Ribblevalley Council carried out any survey work on the Grade 2 listed cottages known as Club Row in respect of vastly increased Passing traffic over the last 200 years .no longer horses and carts .

Ribble Valley planning can dictate what colour our window frames have to be But don't appear to be interested in the structural integrity of Club row.
