Comments: Approval of the applications will cause deep and long lasting harm to the Forest of Bowland AONB and they should be referred to the Secretary of State

In particular the proposal to run large heavy lorries every half an hour - for a period of years - through the Newton in Bowland Conservation Area is impractical - the village has children and is small with narrow roads (some only a few feet wide) and with sharp turns

It would be preferable to run the lorries over the proposed temporary bridge across the River Hodder as was previously proposed
