Dear Sirs

I am writing to you concerning the proposed routes for vehicular access to Newton-in-Bowland.

Although I do not live directly on either of the proposed routes I strongly believe the route via Chatburn, Grindleton and West Bradford should not be used. The existing roads are very narrow and so will require extensive widening and which would involve the loss of existing natural and historic hedges, walls and verges. The vehicles will disrupt these small villages with the potential to damage historic dwellings and put at risk the human and animal life that uses the road.

A far better solution would be the alternative option to create a temporary road from Pimlico to Waddington which avoids much of the disruption.
