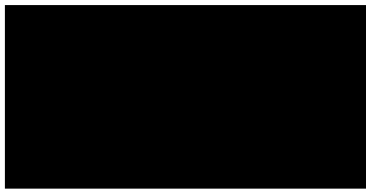
Dear Planners,
