The Supplementary Environmental Information Report (Feb 2022) Table 8 indicates that there are no new or additional likely significant effects to Cultural Heritage above those already indicated.

Our advice therefore remains the same as that provided in July 2021, namely that:

"the proposed mitigation as outlined in section 10.7.1 of the Environmental Statement, Vol.2 is an appropriate means of mitigating any adverse impact of the proposed development" and those works should form a staged programme of post-permission, but pre-construction, archaeological work secured by means of a suitably worded planning condition.
