**Comments:** I am an extremely concerned resident of [REDACTED] regarding this planning application. Specifically with regards to being in an area which is supposedly protected under legislation laid down for an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the Forest of Bowland AONB, along also with it being in close proximity to the Newton Conservation Area.

I feel that Ribble Valley Borough Council have no alternative but to deny the planning application. UU's plans have not taken due regard or followed laid down process to matters contained within the protection that should be safeguarded to the Forest of Bowland AONB to conserve and enhance natural beauty.

Likewise I am concerned by the proposed traffic movements, those contained within Route 1E are surely unpractical given the village's infrastructure, so too is the effect on the environment and ecology in an AONB and the local economy, which will impact via noise and vibration causing damage.

Also the impact the compound will have on light pollution and our dark skies status, has also not been fully considered.

My [REDACTED] will cause a knock on impact on surrounding roads, many which are single tracks and narrow lanes, which are already in a poor state, which increased traffic will see these deteriorate and cause a knock on effect on neighbouring parishes.
