It is becoming more important that area's of countryside that are protected remain so. The every increasing number of new build houses in neighbouring Longridge and Clitheroe mean these area's are increasing used for leisure and it is imperative that they are maintained for the enjoyment of all and that development is kept to a minimum.

Fields Farm Barn has already had renovation/repairs which are not in keeping with this listed building and done with no empathy for the existing property and surrounding area's

I have read this planning application and previous applications. This agricultural building has already been constructed and sticks out like a sore thumb from the public footpath and surrounding highways, it is also visible from some vantage points in the area.

The occupiers of Fields Farm Barn do not carry out any agricultural activity, the land is rented to a local farmer for sheep grazing. Shipping containers have been introduced so that the agricultural building cannot be viewed from the public footpath, in short the whole site is an eyesore. Some of the statements on this, and previous applications, are to say the least not accurate.
