Advice to Local Planning Authority

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) are in receipt of an application for the proposed extension/ alteration to an existing detached garage to form ancillary accommodation to the existing dwelling at Summerfield, Horton-in-Craven, Skipton.

The proposal is to replace the existing garage to provide a two-bed annexe at the site.
