**Estimated Soil Chemistry Cadmium - Slice A**



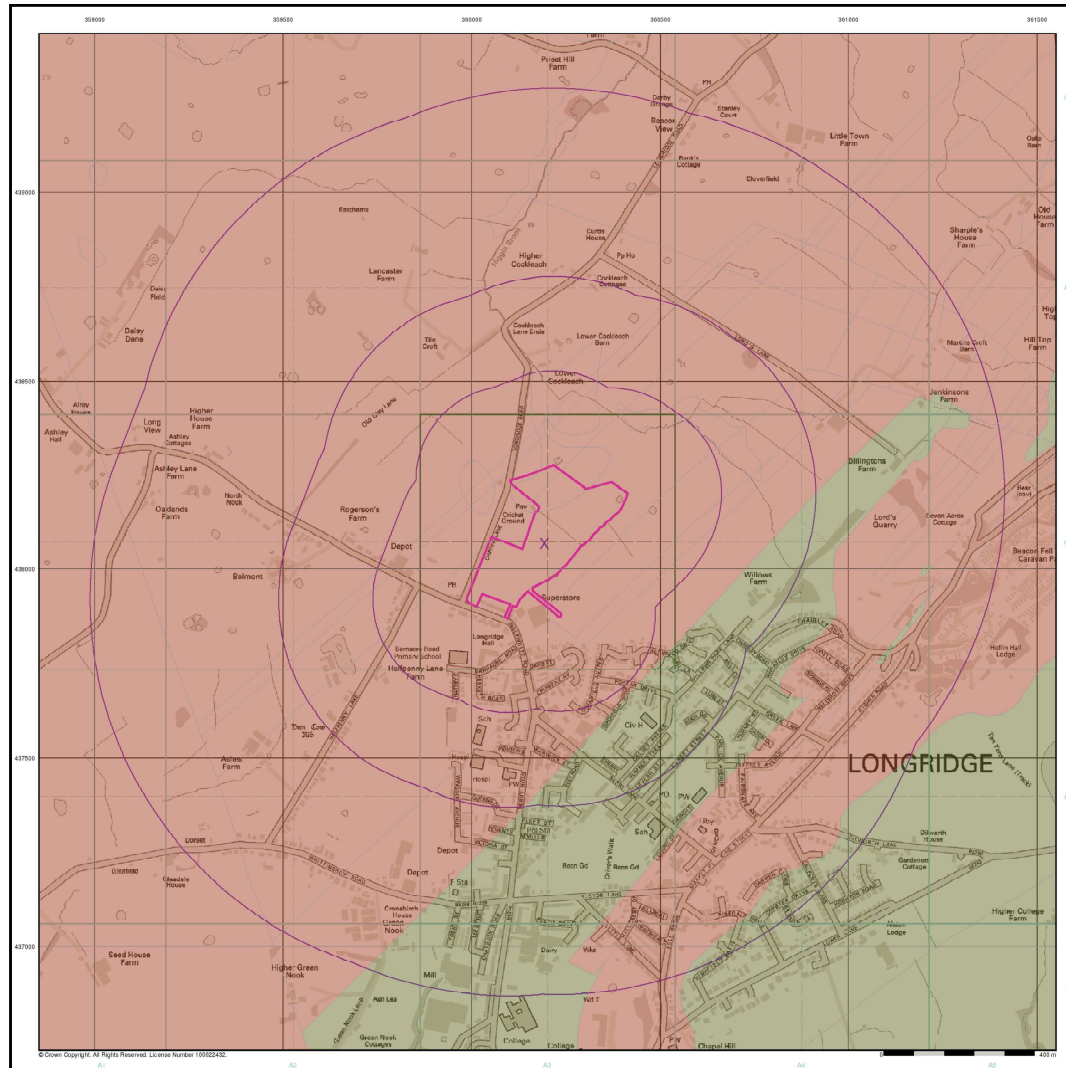
