# **Background**

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) are in receipt of a variation of condition application for Condition 2 (Approved Plans) of planning permission 3/2021/0555 at 42 Knowsley Road, Wilpshire.

The permitted application was for the change of use of a dwelling to a residential institution.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and to clarify which plans are relevant to the consent."

## **Highway Comments:**

The LHA have reviewed the supporting documents and understands that the existing integral garage is being proposed to change to a cinema.

However, the garage was used as one of the parking spaces for the residential institution.

Notwithstanding this, the LHA have reviewed Swift Building Design drawing number 21.052.pl.01 titled "Location and Site Plans" and understands that 3 car parking spaces can still be provided at the site, on the existing driveway. Therefore, even without the garage, the site can still comply with the LHAs parking guidance found in the Joint Lancashire Structure Plan and so the LHA have no objection to the variation of condition.
