Refer to the above pending application and to my Notice of Objection to you dated 14/2/22.

Please note following the visit [REDACTED] by the Planning Officer who kindly noted my specific concerns regarding one aspect of the the Application - the installation of a footpath [REDACTED]

Following his on site observations I then further discussed these principal areas of concern with the Applicant. I am pleased to say that following due consideration, the Applicant and Planning Officer have now very kindly agreed to minor changes to the original plan, with which I am in total agreement.

These minor changes relate to an agreed minimum distance from a preserved Copper Beech tree to the "start line" of the footpath development of 2.5m. There is agreement also that the border between [REDACTED] and the footpath shall be protected by the erection of a solid wooden fence 1.8m high [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] These arrangements are satisfactory and negate the need for my Objection and personal appearance at the Hearing.

I would be most grateful if you would pass on my sincere thanks to the Planning Officer and The Applicant for their kind understanding of the issues involved and their decision to respect these concerns accordingly.
