Dear sir

I am writing about the netting that is located at the rear and to the side of the clubhouse

It is of significant expense to remove the upper posts and netting at the end of September and re-erect these in April. To comply with health and safety the job has become more costly and often the netting is damaged from either taking the netting down or putting the netting back up. Our risk assessments have now identified that a contractor will need to be arranged for the task with an extending boom on a cherry picker. It is also the intention that the club uses the facilities in both March and October and also potentially to seek to play a game in festive period, the average precipitation in August is 50% higher than that in festive period in Lancashire. To allow a game to be played in this period then the nets would need to be in situ

We are therefore asking that the nets can be left in situ for the full 12 months
