Good Morning,

I note that planning permission has been applied for in relation to signs and flags at the development site of Persimmons Homes on Hawthorne Place, Clitheroe, BB7 2HU.

I wish to strongly object on the grounds that these flags will impact negatively on [REDACTED] The proposed location is [REDACTED] Given that the wind blows at night as well as during the day this noise will obviously continue after the site has closed for the day!

I suggest that as the site is tucked away out of sight of passing traffic, at the end of what was a quiet cul de sac, that flags are not required here to attract passing trade. I do feel that if a purchaser wants to view properties they will seek them out and the erection of flags will have no effect on their decisions to buy. All that will be caused by these flags is to further disturb the current residents here which is frankly inconsiderate and unfair.

I ask that permission not be granted in these circumstances for flags and would also ask that the very large signs be reduced in size and positioned well within the site itself so as not to impose on [REDACTED] without such a large eyesore in view.
