Three trees have been damaged by the recent bad weather - please see document for details. We have spoken with an arborist and they have recommended that the trees are removed.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

 - o marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - $\circ\;$ showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - $\circ\;$ adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
