- (3) Flooding and ground water they site in the past has flooded in the past, there is 3 wells on the site one spar and two with clear water. The site belonging to Clitheroe Borough Council, a build a bathhouse on the site in 1838, the Council sold the freehold to Pendle Mill, after that they pulled down the building as you can see from the pictures I have attached there is still a lot of ground water.

Proposed Lower Ground Floor Plan


