Hi Kathryn,

[REDACTED] the development by Persimmon.  
We've just noticed a revised Boundary Treatment plan submitted by Persimmon, aspects of which are causing us concern. Originally there was going to be a 1.8m fence on the far side of the buffer zone with a 1m Laurel hedge in between. The plans show a pink line denoting the new height. [REDACTED] existing fence is only 1.1m (fine when [REDACTED] had an open field) so [REDACTED] have a direct sight line into [REDACTED]. We are pleased the buffer was reinstated and the Laurel hedge bordering [REDACTED] property would be restricted to 1m but Persimmon need to reinstate the 1.8m fence bordering the buffer and new garden. Privacy is important and this change will have a detrimental effect on [REDACTED] prospective neighbours. I would hope you are already aware of this and will advise Persimmon accordingly. Please advise [REDACTED] of any developments in this regard
