We realise our email falls outside the time limit, but hope our comments may be taken into consideration when the planning decision takes place

We object to the proposed caravan site because:-

- Loss of AONB land
- Increased traffic from the bottom of the road up to the proposed site
- Traffic danger due to above + narrowing of the lane and blind corner after 3 Rivers Entrance way (holiday makers won't be used to the lane)
- The Lane is already populated by caravans, and holiday makers will coming to the Pods at Eaves Hall before long
- Increased pedestrian traffic which will lead to more dog fouling and litter. Our experience of same is that once 3 Rivers went to residential usage, litter and dog fouling decreased considerably.
