We wish to comment on the above application. Our comments are mainly related to the traffic problems on Eaves Hall/Moor Lane. The entrance/exit to the site is on a blind bend just after a very narrow single track part of the lane.

The lane (60mph speed limit) is already busy with the various caravan parks and the Evergreen day nursery. It is also used regularly by walkers with and without dogs, cyclists, horse riders and heavy agricultural vehicles.

We consider this new proposed development will add to the dangers on a previously quiet country lane.
