Dear Sarah, I would like to object to above planning application on the grounds of additional and distressing notice and light [REDACTED] Oakhill land.

We received the letter from RVBC regarding the planning application from Oakhill for fencing round the 5-a-side football pitch. Our concerns are as follows;

- We have no problem the pitch being used for the children
- Unfortunately planning permission will allow them to continue using it for adult use in the evenings and weekends.
- Since the adults have been allowed to use the pitch we hear the shouting, swearing and repeated loud banging of the ball hitting the side boarding. This causes great distress to our [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and we have on occasions considered calling the police
- Also in the winter when the trees are bare, the harsh flood lighting [REDACTED]
