Thank you for your consultation on the above applications. We note the content of the applications and the fact that the proposed extension only impacts the modern end of the building. Whilst there have been a number of metal-detector finds in the immediate vicinity, including a section of a medieval shell-shaped lead pilgrim's ampulla (apparently from the cottage garden), we do not consider that the proposed development is likely to impact significant buried archaeological deposits or interfere with the extant historic fabric of the building.

Other than to note the increasing dominance of modern works to this side of what appears to be the oldest building at this end of Worston, we are content to leave judgement on the impacts of the proposal on the building's setting and immediate townscape to the council's expertise.
