I am writing to you today 14/12/22 to put my objection forward for the development at Crow Trees Farm Crow Trees Brow Chatburn BB7 4AA /Pringle homes due to the following reasons.

This area is already a problem with the traffic coming and going into the village, the lane they will be using as access is already a problem with cyclist and pedestrians walking across the access having a few near misses due to poor vision.

Cars coming over the brow do not have a clear view causing problems if vehicles turning right into the lane, which in the past have caused near collisions. Problems continue down the brow having to give way at the top of Ribble lane for on coming traffic which then causes a build up on the brow.

Pollution is also going to be an issue we are suppose to be helping the environment by cutting back on gas emmissions this is going to create a problem to this beautiful countryside.

The plans are 39 affordable housing, how many cars will there be coming in and out of the lane average 2 cars to one household that's 78 extra cars in and out of the , this causing more noise on the road having a hugh impact to this beautiful village.

The design are not in keeping with the surrounding buildings crow trees farm is a grade listed 2 building they should be in keeping with

this which needs sympathetic renovation not comman buildings built around it.

Having looked at the plans it isn't very clear where all the cars are going to park doesn't seem enough parking for the amount of houses being built average 2 cars to each household they will end up parking on the brow this is another concern on the safety aspect on the highway which is already congested causing more danger on the main road into Chatburn village.

The impact on the wildlife concerns me too we have lots of wildlife which lives on the land in question, this will have a devastating impact on the wildlife ,we should be preserving these green pieces of land not building more undesirable houses.

What's going to happen to the trees along the lane and on the land I am sure there will be TPOs on some of these. These have been here for years surely these cant be destroyed.

There has been a ban on green belt and restrictions on planning so why are they allowing a huge development in such a small area we need to be protecting these areas from development, there is enough developments that have been passed in and around Clitheroe which have caused more than enough traffic in the area with no extra infrastructure in place, surely we should be protecting these, beautiful villages

1 there are too many properties within the site which has been agricultural in nature and too much building will detract from the rural nature of the area.

2 this development will swamp the village, introducing a large population increase at once.

3 this development will put too many demands on local services, eg primary school places, and water supply which is already having to be tankered in to the village.

4 the site access es to Crow trees brow road points will seriously contribute to the congestion already existing in this busy village. Given that the speed limit on this road is 30 mph and which is seriously flouted by lorries, buses, taxis and cars often exceeding 50mph without any punishment, the top access point is near the top of Crow trees brow and there will be serious problems with site traffic turning across oncoming traffic lanes, and later residents access.

This development will seriously be to the detriment of quality of life and safety of Chatburn and loss of nearby countryside.
