I have viewed the plans and the highway related documents submitted:

Lancashire County Council acting as the Local Highway Authority does not raise an objection regarding the proposed development and are of the opinion that the proposed development will not have a significant impact on highway safety, capacity or amenity in the immediate vicinity of the site subject to the following conditions being stated on any approval.

There is a proposed vehicular access, ref: Proposed site plan, Nov 22, Drawing no. 03-22-P02 with this proposal.

I would recommend the following condition and informative note:

Condition

- The parking areas must be constructed of a bound porous material and created before first occupation up until the lifetime of the dwellings existing in their proposed state. Reason: To ensure that satisfactory parking is provided before the dwelling hereby permitted becomes operative.
- No development shall take place, including any works of demolition, until a construction method statement has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The approved statement shall be adhered to throughout the construction period. It shall provide for:
- The parking of vehicles of site operatives i)
- ii) The loading and unloading of plant and materials
- The erection and maintenance of security hoarding iii)

- iv) Measures to control the emission of dust and dirt during construction
- v) A scheme for recycling/disposing of waste resulting from demolition and construction works
