Comments: The installation of 3 BT Street Hubs in such a prominent positions within a Conservation area would be too large, extremely unnecessary and totally unacceptable.

These Hubs are very intrusive and would ruin the character of this town. Clitheroe is a Market Town NOT a big city. We have smaller areas for people to negotiate with pushchairs, mobility scooters etc and these Hubs would cause hazards for some people.

The visual impact of the advertising would detract from the beautiful historic town we have, which is the reason people come to visit this lovely area.

BT Street Hubs are not appropriate for Clitheroe and these applications should be refused.
