I strongly object to the above mentioned proposal to instal a BT advertising 'Street Hub' within the Conservation Area of Clitheroe.


Large gaudy installations of this nature are wholly inappropriate for Clitheroe in ANY location and, having considered previous decisions on applications for both listed and non-listed buildings in the Area, I feel sure that the National Planning Policy Framework will give you the adequate means to reject it outright. There are no better words to describe the effect than 'incongruous', 'conspicuous' and 'harmful'.
