Details of the pre-application advice received
"The proposed new access is sited approximately 45m north-east of the existing access on Settle Road C590. Settle Road is subject to the national speed limit which requires visibility splays of 215m to both sides of the access along the near edge of the carriageway of Settle Road. An automatic traffic count has been undertaken between Wednesday 18th – Tuesday 24th November 2020 at the proposed site access. 85%ile speeds are recorded north-east bound 43.5mph and south-west bound 44.7mph which requires splays of 117m and 123m respectively, with a set back distance from the give way line of 2m.  Subject to the visibility splays, described above, being cleared of all vegetation and trees above 1m high, the proposed site access will provide improved visibility splays onto Settle Road in comparison to the existing access due to being located further from the bend to the south. It is noted that the visibility splays at the existing access could be improved by the clearing of the vegetation."
