

material: Cromwell stone
width 297mm

height 378mm thickness to be confirmed but in region of 30mm
fixings: drill and dowel in 4 positions on the back of plaque, and the corresponding hole would then to be drilled using template into the wall, small spacers inserted and an anchor resin used to secure.

Chosen to contest the election in 1902, and elected unopposed. Part-time mill worker from age 9, committed **trade unionist** and **campaigner** for **WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE**, he became just the **third elected LABOUR MP**. Chair of the **parliamentary party**, and of the **TUC**. In 1916 became the first ever **Permanent Secretary** to the new **MINISTRY OF LABOUR**. First working class man to rise to the top of the civil service.
