The submitted documents and plans have been reviewed and the following comments are made.

The amended plans include the removal of the footway alongside the estate road at the junction of Malt Kiln Brow. This is no supported as pedestrians will no safe refuge to stand whilst vehicles manoeuvre at the junction.

The amended road alignment steepens the gradient to 1:10 over the whole length and provides a very steep transition at the junction of Malt Kiln Brow. This is not supported as it is likely to provide insufficient ground clearance for large vehicles and be too steep for pedestrians with mobility issues or pedestrians pushing prams.

The previous alignment provided a maximum gradient of 1:12 with a flatter transition of to the junction which was considered acceptable.

The Highway Authority would raise an to the variation of plans as this would not provide a safe and suitable access.

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
