I understand it has an access door to the front, which at some point was changed to a hatch. It also has a doorway at the rear. Its previous use was for storage at 1 Talbot St

This change is to reinstate the hatch to a doorway to allow disabled access to the property by means of a vertical lift to be installed at the rear doorway of the shed.

The property, a dwelling house, is raised from street level. There is no right access to the property from the rear.

The only existing pathway is a rise of x feet in a distance of y feet. In a total of There is no room for a wheelchair ramp that could meet Disabled access requirements

When the property is viewed from Windy Street the road falls away to the right. Any alternative entrance for a wheelchair would be of greater rise than the existing steps and the view to the direction of traffic when entering or leaving the property is less safe than the existing access

The proposed doorway provides a better view of and for traffic and is thus the safest option.

It is also the minimum change to the property which is located in a conservation area
