Introduction

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) are in receipt of a discharge of condition application to discharge conditions 3 (Demolition Method Statement) and 11 (Construction Method Statement) of planning permission 3/2019/1103. The approved application was to demolish the existing dwelling and erect two dwellings at the site.

Condition 3

"Prior to the demolition of "Twin Brook Farm" a detailed method statement shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Which specifies the method of demolition, disposal of materials and measure to make good and ensure the stability of the adjoining barn. The development shall then commence in strict accordance with the approved details.

Condition 11

"No development shall take place, including any works of demolition, until a construction method statement has been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The approved statement shall be adhered to throughout the construction period. It shall provide for:

The parking of vehicles of site operatives and visitors
The loading and unloading of plant and materials
The storage of plant and materials used in constructing the development
The erection and maintenance of security hoarding
Contact details for the site manager

Reason; In the interests of highway safety."

Highway Comments:

The LHA have reviewed the Construction Management Plan and have no objection to the discharge of condition. The LHA do inform the Developer that separate consent is required from the Lead Local Flood Authority due to works being undertaken adjacent to the watercourse.
