Dear Mr Kilmartin

In principle I have no objection to the above development. However the refuse collection for residents who live on Up Brooks is via a communal collection point as you enter on the left hand side of the road. The refuse collection wagons do not empty individual bins from individual properties. I have in the past complained to the council that in particular the general refuse bin is insufficient for the number of properties on Up Brooks as it is often overflowing. Will there be an increase in either the capacity or frequency of collections as a result of an increase in the number of properties should this development be agreed.

Also on the plans it shows 3 bins allocated to the new property plus at the entrance from Up Brooks to the property it states bin collection ?? is there to be a change as to how refuse is disposed off by the residents ie individual collections??
