

Heritage statement for Rushton house

Rushton house is located on the corner of Lower chapel lane and Main street Grindleton.

The property is C1890 and is Located in its own grounds and is not directly overlooked by any other properties that surround it. Built of stone which is rendered and a traditional slate roof.

The proposal aims to reduce the carbon footprint of the building by fitting solar panels on the roof which is south facing on the house. The panels will be black with black glass to reduce the impact. (information form attached)

The elevation on which the solar panels are proposed to be fit is only visible from one location on main street which is approximately 100m down (south) main street.
