Thanks for contacting us. On closer inspection of your Chestnut trees we have found signs of Honey fungus (Armillaria)

This is a root rot disease and can affect the stability of the tree. As the tree is now so tall your house has become a target. Unfortunately I would recommend removal of the tree to prevent any future damage.
