

Rooflights to attic space have been previously installed and no changes to the principal elevation. The rear extension may be visable to the side of the entrance but due to the topography of the site and its location , this will be barely visable from within the public domain.

The side alteration is proposed to be re-finished in a render finish rather than the combined stone plinth and concrete skim finish which is currently in place. There is also a proposed new window to allow light into the existing landing at the top of the staircase. There is also one window proposed in the extension facing over the boundary. This is a high level window and will be obscured glazed.

The rear of the property will also be re-finished in a render finish. The proposed rear extension will be finsihed in render aswell with one section being completed in Cedar Boarding to break up the new extension from the existing so as to make it visable that it is a modern addition. The rear extension will open into the existing kitchen and will house a garden store , larger overall kitchen and a small utility bathroom. These spaces will be illuminated by two lantern lights , one window and a set of double doors. The extension will be covered by a sedum green roof design.
