The erection of two dugout shelter buildings (each measuring 5.43meter (length) x 1.79meter (width) x 2.4217 meter (height)) from red brick with timber carcass roofing, painted fascia and bitumen felt topping. There will be a 3 - 5 meter space between the two buildings. The buildings will be located on the north side of the site at coordinates 53.80386N, 2.47073W. The buildings will replace the existing temporary shelters that are in place at the site - these are bolted to the ground but are moveable structures.
