

COMMERCIAL REFUSE MANAGEMENT PLAN

53 to 57 Berry Lane, Longridge, PR3 3NH

Pursuant to Planning Application 3/2023/0055

This Waste Management Plan is prepared on behalf of Dominoes Pizza UK and Ireland Ltd, who trade as Domino's Pizza, to in relation to condition 6 of planning permission ref. 3/2023/0055, approved on 23rd June 2023 for the change of use of 53 to 57 Berry Lane, Longridge to a Hot Food Takeaway.

Packaging from deliveries and ingredients is disposed of in lidded wheeled refuse bins, which are kept externally at the rear of the store within the dedicated service yard. Two 1100 litre bins are kept in this area. The area surrounding the bins is inspected regularly to ensure that it remains clean and tidy at all times.

A small amount of food waste is also generated by the cooking process which is put into plastic bin sacks and disposed of in the wheeled refuse bin. The refuse bins are cleaned on a regular basis by a private waste handling company.

Emptying of the wheeled refuse bins is either by regular collections by a private waste handling company on a twice weekly cycle for general rubbish and once a week for recycling, although this is reviewed and increased if required to ensure that food waste is not kept at the site for an extended period.

The bins will be collected directly from the storage area at the rear of the site from Warwick Lane and returned as soon as possible after they are emptied. Bin collections will only take place between 7am and 9pm.

A waste bin is to be provided within the customer waiting area for the disposal of litter by customers. In addition, there is a refuse bin on the pavement outside the premises which can be used by customers if needed.

Staff will inspect the area immediately around the site for litter as part of the closing procedure. This will cover the area outside the front of the premises and to the rear off Warwick Street. A check will also be made of the parking areas.
