Good afternoon

I would like to raise our concerns again regarding the new plans for the expansion of Alston Dairy, in particular the 'New Storage Building'. This proposed building is situated on its own at the far end of the field towards Pinfold Lane and nowhere near any of the other proposed buildings and separated by a hedge/trees.

I would like to raise the follow concerns:

1. This building was previously listed the plans as a farm machinery/log store. The proposed new site is not for agricultural purposes, so why would this be incorporated into the new plans?
2. Why would such a large building be situated away from the main development on its own, and not located near to the other proposed buildings?
3. Why would you build such a large building right in front of someone's property when there is plenty land available to build a store near to the other proposed buildings?
4. If this is a store for the dairy, then why would you have items required by the dairy located so far away?
5. Why would you allow a single large building to be built at one side of a field far away from all the other proposed buildings leaving the remaining field between them?

I do hope the Planning Committee will see some sense and group all the proposed building work together so we do still have a little green space left in Alston.
