The submitted documents and plans have been reviewed and the following comments are made:

It is noted this is a resubmission, our previous comments remain.

Ref Design and Access Statement Inclusive access There is no separate access to the rear of the site, all access to the property is via the front driveway. The vehicular crossing must be the full width of the drive, in order to prevent damage to the f/w.

The proposal should not have a significant detrimental impact on the existing highway network. Therefore, there is no objection to this application subject to the inclusion of the following condition in any grant of planning permission.

Condition

• The parking areas must be constructed of a bound porous material and created before first occupation up until the lifetime of the dwelling existing in its proposed state. Reason: To ensure that satisfactory parking is provided before the dwelling hereby permitted becomes operative.
