I have looked at the drawings supplied showing proposals for new vehicular access off Little Lane at Longridge High School .

Openreach have an asset in the footway as part of the dropped kerb proposals .This footway chamber can support vehicular access and is rated accordingly .As the plans stand Openreach are happy that the proposed plans require no additional protection , diversion or alteration measures by Openreach.

If the proposals were to change for a carriage way entrance where the access road is tied into the existing carriage way levels then Openreach would need alter and divert its duct and cables which is chargeable works.

We also have two wooden telegraph poles in the vicinity of the works and if works progress as per the proposed plans we Openreach do not have any objections to them remaining as they are .
