Proposal: Proposed demolition of boundary wall and creation of new vehicular

access and driveway.

Location: 4 Shaw Terrace Main Street Grindleton BB7 4RA

The submitted documents, plans and pre-app response (29.11.23)has been reviewed and the following comments are made.

With reference to drawing no. 6947-P01 Proposed site plan, section and street scene submitted, this is acceptable.

Driveway/hardstanding

The first 5m of the driveway from the rear of the footway into the site should be surfaced in a bound porous material. This is to prevent loose surface material from being carried onto the surrounding highway network, where it could pose a hazard to other users.

With reference to Design and Access Statement (6947) submitted - vehicular crossing ref CR no. 508305 has been applied for.

In addition, a means of collecting surface water from the driveway should be provided across the access, which should drain to an internal outfall. This is to prevent water from discharging onto the publicly maintained highway network. Details of the means of drainage can either be submitted as part of the planning application or we would request a condition to control it if planning approval is granted.

Conditions

- The parking areas must be constructed of a bound porous material and created before first occupation up until the life time of the dwelling existing in its proposed state. Reason: To ensure that satisfactory parking is provided before the dwelling hereby permitted becomes operative.
- Prior to commencement of the development, details shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority for a surface water drainage scheme. The scheme shall be implemented in accordance with the agreed details prior to first use of the hard standing. For reasons of highway safety to prevent surface water running onto the highway.

Informative Notes

- 1. This consent requires the construction, improvement or alteration of an access to the public highway. A list of approved contractors only, can undertake the approved works under the Highways Act 1980 Section 171. Before any work begins at the site, please contact highways@lancashire.gov.uk for the list of approved contractors and to start the section 171 process
- 2. Prior to the commencement of any works on site, the developer should contact Lancashire County Council's Highway Regulation Team to obtain the relevant permits to work in the adopted highway; they can be contacted on lhsstreetworks@lancashire.gov.uk or on 01772 533433.
