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Description:

This is a small upland farm with severely disadvantaged land, which has been a sheep farm for centuries.
The land continues to support sheep, and in the last 20 years has made use of environmental schemes to increase woodland and hedgerows, enhance meadows, and encourage wading birds to nest.
We have worked with DEFRA, FC, Bowland AONB Meadowmakers, RSPB and Yorkshire Dales Millennium Trust.
We now have support from Forestry Commission to set up a small tree nursery on an unused area of hardstanding as part of the England Trees Action Plan to treble new woodland creation for climate and for wildlife.
Our plan is to supply young trees to new woodland schemes in the local area.
