**Comments:** I write in support of this planning application. There appears to be no logical reason why the solar panels cannot be fitted right to the edge of the roof. The legislation being applied relates to non-domestic buildings which presumably can include vast warehouses where losing a metre around the edge of the roof is of no consequence.

In the case of the Pavilion, having to restrict the area that the solar panels can occupy will lead to a significant reduction in energy production and represent less good value for money as well as reducing the future energy production and cost savings for Grindleton Recreation Ground Charity.

Equally important is the fact that aesthetically solar panels look much better when fitted up to the edge of the roof rather than having a gap all round. The Pavilion is the new building which has fit into the area of outstanding natural beauty very well with its random stone construction and slate roof. I think the aesthetics is an important consideration.
