#### Supporting

- No alteration to the site red edge is put forward by this application. The red edge is in line with that approved under application ref. 3/2019/0277;
- Due to level differences and site topography it has been necessary to construct retaining walls to between plots and to site boundaries to comply with planning. The detail attached to this application was approved under application ref. 3/2016/0984;
- Due to level differences and site topography it has not been possible to insert trees along the northern and eastern site boundaries. Compensatory tree planting Using the approved amount inserted on site which is over and above the amount shown on landscaping plan approved under application ref. 3/2019/0277;
- Bird & bat boxes installed are in line with the plan approved under application 3/2016/0984, save only for the manufacturer and are colour coded in keeping with the House rather than Grey Concrete colour. Location, style, mounting and quantities are all the same as approved details. There is no net loss to Habitat.
