Dear Planning Department,

I am writing to formally object to the above planning application.

The unit in question has been installed on an external wall that [REDACTED]

The unit is situated above [REDACTED]

When planning permission was granted for the two-storey extension of this property, [REDACTED]. However, at no point was an air source heat pump mentioned. We believe that this should have been included in the original plans, allowing for alternative placements to be considered, such as on another external wall [REDACTED]. The current placement of this unsightly unit detracts from the visual amenity of the area, and its visibility [REDACTED], combined with the daily noise it generates—[REDACTED]—has become a significant nuisance.

Moreover, we are concerned about the potential fire risk associated with any electrical appliance. The unit is positioned directly above a wooden fence, which is particularly troubling.

We also question how this unit can be adequately serviced and maintained, given the insufficient space between the extension wall [REDACTED].

I would appreciate an update on the status of this planning application, as I first raised my concerns on [REDACTED].
