Dear Kathryn Hughes

I am writing to object to the application for up to 100 weddings per year, an increase of 150%. This together with permission already granted for 10 holiday lodges will create further traffic pressure on Cross Lane, a single track road with 3 hazardous double bends and few passing places. The County Surveyor has expressed concern in the past on the amount of traffic using the lane and any substantial increase will impinge on the safety of all users of the road including pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists.

We understand that the County Surveyor had recommended that traffic to and from the wedding venue be one way and the exit route should be through Clough Bottom Farm and the village of Bashall Eaves.
