Please see attached map for the location of the stock proof fencing, I've also attached a copy of the fencing specification which shows the height of the fencing will be approximately 1.09m in height.

Please see attached photograph for gate access (SD673453, What3Words: swing.headings.brightens) where vehicles will be accessing the site. A site compound will be set up for machinery that will be arriving to site on the first day, machinery will likely be an excavator under 10tonne with attachments.
