We understand that a further alteration to this application has been submitted, involving movement of this shed to near the gate by the lane. There has never been any sort of pen for animals here and we believe that to place a shed here with associated machinery would be inappropriate. We cannot understand why the application has suddenly decided to move the shed to this place from the original planned site around the corner. This lane is used by many walkers and cyclists, as well as by the residents and we feel that placing the shed here without good reason would be a significant detriment to the beauty of the area, whereas the previous site was more out of the way and less intrusive. (Although we make the point again that there has only been a pen here for a matter of weeks.
