Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing in support of Ms. Swingler's application for a residential dwelling at NJS rehabilitation, BB7 3DG. Ms. Swingler is a qualified osteopathic practitioner and is an active member of RAMP and IRVAP regulatory bodies. The applicant is responsible for the rehabilitation of horses often following surgical or medical procedures performed at my practice. I choose to refer horses to Ms. Swingler for their aftercare following orthopaedic interventions. Ms Swingler also has an established caseload of her own, offering rehabilitation livery to individual clients and other para-professionals. It is essential that the applicant develops a residential dwelling on this site to be able to care for these animals on a 24/7 basis. Driving back and forth from Clitheroe to attend to these animals has the potential to compromise their welfare and security whilst under her care. A residential dwelling is also necessary for clients and veterinary surgeons to use toilet facilities and to provide shelter from the weather whilst attending these animals, frequently from distances far away.
