Replacement driveway application.

The existing parking arrangement is tight and difficult to use, with the drive only allowing one car to park and a second to block in line with the flow of traffic on the road, additionally, this then requires the occupants to access the house through the garden which has uneven steps.

There is a secondary pedestrian access to the east of the dwelling, which is the main guest accepting entrance, however there is no footpath to this part of the road and nowhere for pedestrians to alight vehicles.

The proposals seek to replace the existing drive to the west of the site with a new one to the east. This access will better serve the occupants and how they enter the house both from vehicles and on foot. The proposed driveway will provide vehicular access from Abbott Brow and have parking for a minimum of 3 cars, it will also improve the occupants pedestrian access to the house via proposed path from the vehicle hardstanding. The proposed drive will be finished in a bound porous material with drainage. The hedge row will be trimmed to provide adequate visibility splays from the replacement driveway.

As per liaison and advise from LCC, the existing driveway will be incorporated into the garden once the works to the replacement drive are complete.

## Biodiversity net gain
